The Governor's Citation is designed to recognize clubs that are effective and make a significant difference to their community and to communities around the world. The criteria are established such that every club in the district should be able to earn enough points for this award.

**Procedure**

Fill out the writable version of this document (available on the District Training website), and email it to your Assistant Governor by April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012. All contributions and membership numbers are as of March 31<sup>st</sup> 2012. The winning clubs will be recognized at the District Conference in June 2012.

*Humanitarian Service  
(890 points possible)*

- Have at least one Rotarian serve as a project volunteer in another country. (50 points)

- Sponsor at least one student for RYLA (10 points)
- Apply for a District Simplified grant for a local or international project (20 points)
- Carry out an environmental service project (20 points)
- Sponsor a Youth Exchange student (20 points)
- 10% decrease in the number of members who are not Paul Harris Fellows (50 points)
- Have a Major Donor in your club (50 points)
- Have at least 75% of your members be Benefactors (50 points)
- Have 100% of your Rotarians contribute to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund (50 points)
- Have a new Bequest Society member (50 points)
- Have a Paul Harris Society member in your club (50 points)
- Contribute at least \$40 per Rotarian to the District Project (50 points)
- Contribute at least \$50 per Rotarian to the District Project (additional 30 points)
- Contribute at least \$75 per capita to TRF Annual Fund. (50 points)
- Contribute at least \$100 per capita to TRF Annual Fund (additional 100 points)
- Contribute at least \$40 per capita to Polio Plus. (50 points)
- Contribute at least \$50 per capita to Polio Plus. (additional 30 points)

*Strengthen Clubs  
(350 points possible)*

- Sponsor a new Rotary, Interact or Rotaract Club. eClub's count! (100 points)
- Sponsor an existing Interact or Rotaract club (50 points)
- Retain 85% of club members from April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 through April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. (50 points)
- Achieve a minimum net gain in membership of 1 for every 50 or fewer Rotarians in the club. (50 points)
- Submit by email your Planning Guide for Effective Rotary Clubs goals to your Assistant Governor by March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011. (10 points)
- Submit by email your TRF Club Goal Report to your Assistant Governor by March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011. (10 points)
- Report your incoming officer information to RI using Member Access by Dec 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011. (10 points)
- Have at least 1 member per 50 or fewer Rotarians register for the district conference by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. (50 points)
- Have at least one Rotarian attend a district Foundation Event (10 points).
- Have at least 1 Rotarian attend a Rotary Leadership Institute event. (10 points)

*Enhancing Public Image and Awareness  
(170 points possible)*

- Hold a Polio awareness event as part of the District on World Polio Day. (50 points)
- Work with the district on a Public Relations project. (50 points)
- Partner with an organization in your community on at least one community service project. (50 points)
- Organize at least one professional networking event in which club members can meet with other local professionals and introduce them to Rotary (20 points)
